
Enclosed you will find a list of classes and your student's 2023/2024 schedule. This is on a first come first served basis. Students will receive an additional schedule in their homeroom on the first day of school.

For your convenience we have enclosed a 2023/2024 School District Calendar, a registration form, a health information card, an Internet Information Consent form, the KI permission form, the School-Parent Compact, Electronic Device Agreement and the Household Information Survey for the Community Eligibility Provision. It is imperative that these forms are completed and returned to the school. Please feel free to drop them off at the school, or you can also return them with your student on the first day of school. Your timely assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated. Also enclosed in this packet is important information including our, a flier regarding our uniform policy, our HIB policy, an Emergency Response Plan/School Fact Sheet, and letters regarding our Family Life Education Curriculum, Pupil Records, Right to Know, and the Student Accident Insurance Flier.

Please try to be very accurate when filling out all forms so that we always have the correct information for your child. We continually update our database so that all our correspondence arrives at your home and that we have the accurate phone numbers to contact you. Along with educating your student, your child's safety is a major concern. When it becomes necessary for a student to be released from school early, **the parent/guardian (who is indicated on the registration form) is required to come in personally the day of the scheduled appointment and sign the early dismissal sheet located in the main office. If the parent/guardian is unable to pick up the student, they must contact an administrator who has the authority to release your student to someone other than yourself. That person must then sign the early dismissal sheet.** Thank you for your attention in this matter. If you have any questions, please contact me at the school.
