A minimum of 130 credits which must include: 4 years of Language Arts, 3 years of Mathematics, 3 years of Science, 1 year of World History, 2 years of US History, 4 years of Heath and Physical Education, 1 year of Fine and/or Performing Art & 1 year of a Practical Art, 1 year of World Language and passing scores on one of the following standardized tests: SAT, ACT, PARCC, ASVAB, PSAT and/or Accuplacer.
